

Janet Carver Recognized with 2021 Women Worth Watching in STEM Award

The award recognizes women for their contributions, leadership, mentoring, and achievements in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (STEM). Candidates are nominated by a leader or colleague from their organization. This year, 28 women from 19 companies comprised the third class of honorees.

"I am inspired to serve in this role and share my experiences with others," said Carver. "Taking the time to mentor, develop and create an environment which inspires women to thrive, grow and succeed is rewarding to me."
