Ingredion's latest grade in Climate Change improved on the prior year when the Company received a B.

CDP highlighted Ingredion's efforts with the supply chain and manufacturing process for RebM to help make it a low-emissions product and called out the low water intensity process used at the Company's Vanscoy, Canada facility.
